## **POSITIONS:**

**REGISTRATION** - Check in guests in a positive and professional manner, provide basic registration information to guests using electronic technology (training will be provided, but volunteers should be comfortable using tablets, ipads, or similar technology), upon check in and answer any questions they may have. **(Shift time: 4:15pm – 7:00pm)**

**GAMING TABLE COORDINATOR** – Support the dealer at the poker table by selling and signing off poker chips to players when they wish to “buy in”. \*Please note, gaming table coordinators will be using electronic tablets (training will be provided, but volunteers should be comfortable using tablets, ipads, or similar technology). In addition to the online training, an onsite orientation will be provided, and please note, knowledge of poker is not required for this role. **(Shift time: 5:30pm – 9:30pm)**

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- Dinner will be provided for all volunteers.
- Volunteers will be asked to attend an in-person training/orientation session on Wednesday, June 08<sup>th</sup> 2022 from 11:00am-12:00pm in No Limits Boardroom of SickKids Foundation. A recorded version of the orientation will be sent out to everyone who cannot make it. (An in-person recap will also be provided for volunteers before beginning their role on event day).

## **PROOF OF VACCINATION**

Health and safety during the COVID-19 pandemic has been our top priority. As a member of the broader SickKids Hospital community, it is imperative that we do our part to protect all those carrying out activities on SickKids related premises.

SickKids Foundation requires all our volunteers attending the event to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 (a mix of at least 2 accepted vaccines, with the exception of those with a validly documented medical or human rights exemption which must be provided to SickKids Foundation in advance). Proof of vaccination is required even if that exceeds the minimum government and public health guidelines. Proof of vaccination along with a government issued ID will be required upon arrival.
