ABOUT THE EVENT:

Scrubs in the City is in its 21st year and has quickly become one of SickKids Foundation's most anticipated and highly regarded Signature Events, with over 1,000 guests expected to attend.

Scrubs fuses fantastic food, energized entertainment, and eye-popping décor, into the essence of one of the world's most glamourous cities. Scrubs is where Toronto's philanthropic glitterati rub shoulders (and clink glasses). It's the scene to be seen.

Scrubs 2022 Theme – Nashville: As real as a worked-in cowboy hat. As magic as the chic-est pair of killer heels. Scrubs Nashville is both down-home and dressed-up. And hot. We're bringing the heat of a steamy Southern night: the hottest music, the most sizzling fashion, and delish Nashville staples like hot chicken.

POSITIONS:

REGISTRATION - Check in guests using tablets or computer check in system, verify vaccine passports, answer any questions they may have regarding the event and provide them with information on the program of the evening. Onsite training will be provided for the check-in technology. **(Shift time: 4:30pm - 8:30pm)**

GREETERS/DIRECTIONAL ASSISTANTS - Stationed throughout the venue, both inside and outside, the greeters and directional assistants will welcome Scrubs guests as they arrive and direct them to their destination, ensuring that the guests have a warm welcome upon arrival. Directional assistants will also assist the guests in locating parking spots and directing them to the entrance of the venue. (Shift time: 4:30pm - 8:30pm)

SILENT AUCTION ASSISTANTS - Circulate throughout the venue during the event ensuring that guests are comfortable using the tablet technology for the auction and answering any questions they may have about the prizes. (Shift time: 5:00pm - 10:00pm)

ACTIVATIONS- Assist the photographers and guests as they take pictures during the evening from the event's photo booths and help support the other activations throughout the night. **(Shift time: 5:00pm-12:00am)**

COAT CHECK- Coat check volunteers will receive and retrieve guests' coats and ensure items are secure during the event. **(Shift time: 4:30pm-12:00am)**

EVENT TEAR DOWN - At the end of the evening volunteers will assist in closing down the event including deconstructing signage, moving furniture, packing supply bins into event vehicle, and restoring the event venue to its original state.

PROOF OF VACCINATION

SickKids Foundation requires all Scrubs in the City volunteers, guests, staff, and vendors attending the event to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 (a mix of at least 2 accepted vaccines or at least 1 dose of the Janssen/Johnson & Johnson), with the exception of those with a validly documented medical or human rights exemption which must be provided to SickKids Foundation in advance. Proof of vaccination is required even if that exceeds the minimum government and public health guidelines. Proof of vaccination along with a government issued ID will be required upon arrival.
